

Oreo Scarf



I made this scarf using two colours, cream and chocolate and the result reminded me of an oreo (hence the name). Five colour changes are made, resulting in 25 cables. This can easily be made as a solid colour scarf, one just has to repeat the pattern ignoring the colour change instructions.

Any worsted weight yarn will do.

I used a 5mm (US 8) set of needles.

Special stitches:

- C6B: Transfer 3 stitches from left needle to cabling needle or dpn, place behind work. Knit next 3 stitches on left needle, knit three stitches on cabling needle, without twisting work.

Cast on 45 stitches.

Row 1 (RS): K9 P3 K6 P3 K3 P3 K6 P3 K9

Row 2 (WS): K6 P3 K3 P6 K3 P3 K3 P6 K3 P3 K6

Repeat rows 1-2 four times.

Row 3 (RS, cable row): K9 P3 C6B P3 K3 P3 C6B P3 K9

Repeat row 2.

Repeat rows 1-2 five times, repeat row 3 then row 2 for pattern.

Every fifth cable, introduce colour change after the second 1-2 rep on RS row. Knit entire row for the first row of colour change counting it as a row 1. Continue in pattern.

After the fifth colour change, knit in pattern 5 cables. Cast off after 4th 1-2 rep.
